- Partnership Presentation:
 - Literacy Week event -February 1st -We will be participating in Family Play Day 2014 as part of the Winter Festival and sponsored by MOST for Children
 - Postcard Story Contest - Olympic theme in broad sense - for high school students, prize to be an Olympic hockey sweater - in planning stages
- Teen & Youth programming - Interim report for United Way funding has been prepared.
