2015 Proposed General Budget: Response from Town Council via letter from Leslie Ford	Wendy	Frank says that SPL had an average of 6% increases over past few years, and there were a lot of community asks, this year, so the Town gave the Board \$5,000 and will let the trustees decide how to spend it. Mission/Vision/Strategic Plan	Wally	There is a two-step approval process because the Board wants to be inclusive. The Board will review it and Wendy will present it to the staff for feedback before the Board votes on it at their March meeting. Wendy communicated staff feedback on the new Mission and Vision statements. The Board has reviewed the Mission/Vision statement and has a comfort level with it. Wendy will ask the staff if they have any more feedback for the Board before trustees vote on it at their March meeting.
		Strategic Plan: A Town of Smithers Community Needs Assessment will not happen; instead, Councillors Frank Wray and Greg Brown will go out to interested groups with questions (starting next week and through March). The meetings won't necessarily be about the next civic project. Therefore, the Community Needs Assessment as an Action in

		SPL's SP should be removed, but all the tasks under that heading are still valid.
		The Community Needs Assessment action will be changed to read: "Promote a new or alternate library to better serve the residents of the Bulkley Valley."
		The order of the two tasks Find Viable Groups (currently first) and Strike a Marketing Committee (currently second) will be switched.
		Lorraine suggests we do a survey, in person at the library.
North Coast Library Federation (NCLF)	Wendy	The NCLF's Library Directors Advisory Group (LDAG) & the NCLF Board will meet in Smithers Saturday, April 18 to work on strategic planning. The Dean of Northwest Community College will decide whether to resume the shipping arrangement that ended in November (a cost-saver for Smithers PL). Training money will probably be used to send some staff members from each library to either Beyond Hope or BCLA. The directors are currently voting on a costume to share during August (for the BVX parade).
