### **Ongoing Programs**

**Storytime** will still be held on Wednesdays and **LEGO Time** on Thursdays A **Book Club** and the **Smithers Board Games Group** meet at the library monthly.

#### **Professional Development**

Library staff viewed a video shared by the Dze L K'ant Friendship Centre about Indigenous homelessness.

Smithers Situation Table representatives attended December and January staff meetings, role-playing common challenging interactions at the library and initiating a staff support group.

Wendy's tenure as Co-Chair of the BCLA Intellectual Freedom Committee (IFC) ended December 31, 2023, with the committee's reorganization and change of mandate. She will continue to work with the new committee and the broader BCLA membership in revising BCLA's Intellectual Freedom Statement for Board approval.

#### **Building**

Electrical outlets along the outer edge of the adult reading area have been replaced with new ones closer to seating. This safety and accessibility initiative, funded by the provincial Enhancement Grant, removed the trip hazard created by patrons' laptop cords strung across the aisle to reach plug-ins.




## **Library Usage**
